CHALLENGE

This project was initially awarded to a competitor; however, that competitor was not able to meet their bid price or the established deadline. Tri City Glass & Door was brought in late on the job with the expectation of meeting both the original deadline and bid price.

UNIQUE ISSUES

- ▲ One-of-a-kind design required one-of-a-kind solutions
- ▲ Exterior faces of the building are entirely covered in glass
- ▲ "A" structure caused cramped working conditions
- ▲ Reduce ultra-violet (UV) rays and boost R-Value
- ▲ Non-standard glass and aluminum shapes

SOLUTION

Tri City Glass & Door met the aggressive deadlines and the original bid price, which allowed Andy's Petro Pantry to open the doors and start generating income on schedule. Using high-performance custom products, Tri City Glass & Door provided solutions to create a unique stopping experience, reduce energy costs and maintain the design that made this building so attractive.
